SightLogix, Cisco Systems and Panasonic surveillance package enables rapid-response scene monitoring capabilities for first responders across the nation

Princeton, NJ – March 10, 2009 – SightLogix, Inc., maker of automated [outdoor surveillance](#) products for high-value/high-consequence infrastructure protection, has delivered a \$1.66 million U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) contract for the 2008 DHS Commercial Equipment Direct Assistance Program (CEDAP). As part of the contract, the CEDAP program has provided SightLogix' long-range, wireless perimeter surveillance and scene monitoring Rapid Deployment Kit, along with product training and technical support to public safety agencies across the nation.

municipalities across the United States. A two-day training exercise with representatives from the local law enforcement recipients was held at the Grand Hyatt-Washington DC on February 9-11, 2009.
